Year 11 Intervention

I am sure you are aware of the importance of intervention and the opportunity it provides your child to catch up on any gaps in their knowledge. Attendance at intervention sessions is extremely important for examination success. To put this into perspective, in the 2022-23 academic year we had pupils that attended every session and improved their results by multiple grades. This level of effort and achievement opens many more opportunities when it comes to further education and career paths.

Therefore, we ask for your support in discussing with your child / children, how important their intervention attendance is to reach their true potential. We also ask pupils to appreciate that teachers are giving up their personal time to help pupils improve their knowledge and results.

Interventions sessions have now commenced, both in Form Tutor time on a morning and afterschool.
