Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: RSE Curriculum (0035-23KTH)

It is an expectation of the Department for Education that we share information regarding Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) with parents / carers. RSE is delivered during both the 'Life' curriculum programme and Form Tutor time.

During term two (January to April), your child's class will be taking part in lessons which will focus on Relationships and Sex Education (RSE). RSE lessons will include teaching about: Healthy relationships, including friendships and intimate relationships; families; growing and changing, including puberty; personal hygiene; changing feelings; becoming more independent; keeping safe and consent; developing self-esteem and confidence.

The RSE plan is outlined below:

Year 7	Pupils will learn about different types of relationships, including core values; healthy and
	unhealthy relationships; aspects of a romantic relationship and contraception; pressures to
	go into intimate relationships and consent.
Year 8	Pupils will build on their prior knowledge and learn about sexual orientation and identity;
	peer pressure and avoiding assumptions; introduction to contraception and sexually
	transmitted infections; health during puberty and the facts about reproductive health,
	including Female Genital Mutilation (FGM).
Year 9	Pupils will have the opportunity to further develop their knowledge by looking at sexual and
	reproductive health; contraception methods and sexually transmitted infections; pregnancy
	outcomes and pregnancy choices.
Year 10	Pupils will learn about the effects of drugs and alcohol and their effects on inhibitions and
	behaviour; the impact pornography has on relationships; key facts on sexual transmitted
	diseases and how different sexual transmitted Infections can be reduced through safer sex.
Year 11	Aspects of the Year 10 curriculum will be picked up at various points through the year.
