Dear Parent / Carer,

Re: Year 7 History Visit to York (0095-23JBA)

The History Department is pleased to offer your child the opportunity to take part in an enrichment visit to York on either **Monday 15th July** or **Tuesday 16th July 2024**. It will involve a visit to the Jorvik Viking Centre as well as a guided walk around York. The experience will give pupils an opportunity to tour a historically significant UK city as part of personal development, and it will compliment your child's Year 7 Curriculum.

On the day of the visit, after receiving their morning registration mark, pupils will meet in the main hall at 8.45am ready to depart promptly at 9.00am. Pupils will be travelling to the destination by coach. We aim to return to Longfield by approximately 3.00pm.

Pupils will not be required to wear school uniform for the visit. However, pupils must ensure they wear appropriate clothing for the weather conditions, as well as suitable footwear for walking throughout the day. Pupils will also need a packed lunch and refreshments. If your child is entitled to a free school meal and would like a packed lunch provided by the school, please indicate this on the electronic registration of interest form.

The total cost of the visit is **£19**, which includes transport and entrance fee to Jorvik.

Please be aware, due to restricted seating on the coach, each visit is limited to 40 pupils. After the deadline has passed, all registrations of interest will be collated. If the visit is oversubscribed, places will be allocated via a random selection process. We will then inform parents / carers as to whether their child has been successful in securing a place and on which date they will visit. If you would like your child to take part, please complete the registration of interest form via the link below. Deadline for registration is midnight on Monday 3rd June 2024.
