Uniform

Please support us to ensure that the following items of uniform are compliant with our expectations. Failure to comply may result in pupils being required to borrow items from the school.

Please be aware, if pupils refuse to accept our alternatives, a sanction may be imposed.

A reminder that skirts are no longer part of our uniform. Please comply with this expectation to avoid any unnecessary conversations and/or disruptions to your child's learning when we return on <u>Tuesday 3rd September 2024.</u>

We will continue with the summer uniform until after October half term when we will change to the winter uniform of shirt, tie and jumper.

Years 7 – 10 will wear a tie with a silver background and a navy stripe.

Year 11 – will wear a tie with a navy background and a silver stripe (one tie will be given to them on their first day in school in September 2024.

Uniform Expectations: -

- Black school shoes not trainers. Shoes should not have badges or embellishments.
- Trousers must have a **button and zip** fastening (not just decoration). Leggings are not permitted.
- Please ensure <u>all</u> uniform and PE kit has your child's name written on the tag so we can return it if it gets misplaced.
- All jewellery must be left at home (with the exceptional of a conventional watch smart watches are not permitted). If jewellery is worn, it will be confiscated and while every attempt will be made to keep it safe, we will not take responsibility for lost items.
- Piercings of any kind are <u>not</u> allowed. This is for health and safety reasons. New piercings <u>will not</u> be accepted as a reason to wear / refusal to remove them.

Equipment
